We're writing today with an important update about CALL's annual conference. Given the extent of the cutbacks that have already taken place at many college campuses, and the fact that faculty members are still working without a new collective agreement, the Board has decided to postpone the 2025 conference until the fall.

The hope is that the current state of uncertainty will have levelled out enough by then for the Board, together with the Local Organizing Committee at Niagara College, to be able to host the conference as planned in Niagara-on-the-Lake.

We debated pivoting to a virtual conference, but the consensus among board members has been that this year's conference theme of "Working Together for a Human-Centred Approach to Teaching and Learning in Modern Contexts" is best suited to an in-person meeting, not least because most of us are (now more than ever) in need of the comradery that the CALL conference provides.
