- ✓ **Preferred format:** panel presentation, roundtable/facilitated discussion (work-in-progress, question-posing, shared-text), interactive workshop, gallery walk, creative display or other format
- ✓ **Preferred session length:** 30 or 60 minutes
- ✓ **AV or other requirements**

Presenters are encouraged to prepare in-person sessions with considerations for online streaming. Virtual sessions will be considered.
